SACRAMENTS

Reconciliation - Saturdays at 3:00 p.m., Weekdays: 15 minutes prior to Mass or please call the pastor at 255-4600 for an appointment. If you are homebound and unable to come to the Church and need a priest to come to your home for confession, please call 255-4600 to set this up.

Baptism - The Baptism Preparation Program and Baptism Schedule are by arrangement. Please call the parish office at 255-4600 to register prior to your delivery date and the program director will return your call. Parents must be registered at Corpus Christi or have permission from their parish.

Marriage - Couples planning to be married should call the parish office at 255-4600 at least four months in advance. Completion of required paperwork and taking the FOCCUS premarital inventory is also needed this early. This process is usually administered the fourth Thursday of each month from 7:00-9:00 p.m.

Natural Family Planning Classes are offered by the Bismarck Diocese. The methods offered are Billings Ovulation Method, Creighton Model Fertility Care System, Marquette Model and Sympto-Thermal Methods. WHAT DOES THE TRINITY MEAN TO US?

“We believe in one Father”: Yet look at the world and see what we accept and who we reject, who we love and who we hate. With such division and derision, can we really believe that we are all children of one Father?

“We Believe in one Son”: Yet walk through the streets and see the starving, the homeless, the sick, while others live in luxury or excess. Do we really believe they all have the same Brother as we?

“We believe in one Spirit”: Yet watch those who give selflessly in compassion, while others sit idle and carefree. Are we really hearing and serving with the same Spirit?

To believe in the Trinity is not to believe in a thing, an object, a model, a definition or an idol. To believe in the Trinity means to believe in action, in dynamic revolutionary force, in a power that can change the face of this earth. And if this belief does not bring that change, that power, that force into your own heart, why do you say you believe?

Stewardship Thought: How much you have has nothing to do with generosity to God. If you don't give of your time, talent and treasure with what you already have, you most likely won't do it if you have more.

Vocation Views: The love of God is being poured forth into our hearts. Open yourself to receive and share that love. Is God calling you to spread love through a Church vocation? (Romans 5:1-5)

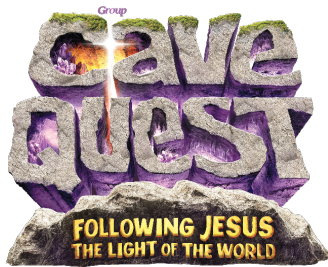

The Holy Father Speaks... If you say you are in communion with the Lord, then walk in the light and say "no" to double lives! Not that! And we know where that lie comes from: in the Bible, Jesus calls the devil 'the father of lies', the liar. It's for this reason that this grandfather says with infinite tenderness and meekness to the 'adolescent' Church: 'Don't be a liar! You are in communion with God, walk in the Light. Do works of light, don't say one thing and do another. No to double lives and all that. We have a Paraclete, a word, an advocate, a defender at the Father's side, it's Jesus Christ, the Upright One. He makes us righteous. It is He who pardons us. We must walk in the light because God is greatness and it's from Him alone that we can get our strength. We must walk in the light because God is light. Don't walk with one foot in the light and the other in darkness. Do not be liars. We have all sinned, no one can say 'This man is a sinner, this woman is a sinner. I, thanks to God, am upright.' No, only one is Upright, He who paid for us. And if somebody sins, He is waiting for us and pardons us because He is merciful and knows very well what we are shaped from and remembers that we are but dust. May the joy that this message gives us, carry us forward in the simplicity and the transparency of the Christian life, above all when we turn to the Lord..... with truth.
