SACRAMENTS

Reconciliation - Saturdays at 3:00 p.m., Weekdays: 15 minutes prior to Mass or please call the pastor at 255-4600 for an appointment. If you are homebound and unable to come to the Church and need a priest to come to your home for confession, please call 255-4600 to set this up.

Baptism - The Baptism Preparation Program and Baptism Schedule are by arrangement. Please call the parish office at 255-4600 to register prior to your delivery date and the program director will return your call. Parents must be registered at Corpus Christi or have permission from their parish.

Marriage - Couples planning to be married should call the parish office at 255-4600 at least four months in advance. Completion of required paperwork and taking the FOCCUS premarital inventory is also needed this early. This process is usually administered the fourth Thursday of each month from 7:00-9:00 p.m.

Natural Family Planning Classes are offered by the Bismarck Diocese. The methods offered are Billings Ovulation Method, Creighton Model Fertility Care System, Marquette Model and Sympto-Thermal Methods. PRAYER TREE: 255-4600

Daily wrongs, daily crosses. At the end of each day we could all compile a list of the grievances, the wrongs done to us. Over dinner tables across the country a litany of hurts, large and small, is recited along with the refrain, "I'm a good person, I'm a Christian, why me?" Why not? Jesus promised us many things, but He never promised an easy path. In fact, He told us that each and every day of our life we would be called to pick up a cross and carry it, no matter how bruised our backs, how splintered our hands or how weary our hearts. Jesus offers us His compassion and mercy, His companionship on the suffering road, but He never once offered to remove the burden. We follow Jesus most closely when we accept those daily wrongs as He would, with patience, tolerance and prayer. It is only then, when we view life's grievances as opportunities to share His cross, that we can conquer our weakness and grow. What cross will you carry today?

Take up your cross. "To take up the cross of Christ is no great action done once for all! It consists of the continual practice of small duties which are distasteful to us."

Stewardship Thought: Every one of us is talented in some way. Stewardship encourages us to use any talent we have to benefit an individual, the Church or the community.

Vocation Views: Love abounds when forgiveness is experienced. Forgiveness frees one to follow Jesus. Rededicate your life to Jesus. (Luke 7:36-8:3)

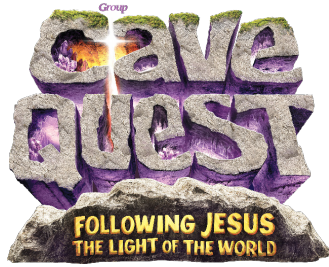
SPANISH MASS

The Holy Father Speaks... "We now consider the first of Jesus' miracles, the changing of water into wine at the wedding feast of Cana," Pope Francis told the crowds gathered in St. Peter's Square, according to the official English-language synthesis of his remarks. "St. John fittingly calls these miracles 'signs,' for by them the Lord reveals the Father's merciful love."

"Jesus' choice of a wedding feast points to the deeper meaning of this miracle," Pope Francis continued. "It is a sign of the new covenant that he came to inaugurate, the messianic banquet promised for the end times, where he is the Bridegroom and the Church his bride."

The Pope added: "By changing the water kept for ritual purification into new wine, Jesus signals that he is the fulfillment of the Law and the Prophets. Mary's command to the servants - "Do whatever he tells you" - can serve as a program of life for the Church. We are called constantly to renew our love for the Lord, and to draw new wine, new life, from his saving wounds. The miracle at Cana reminds us that we are invited, as members of the Lord's family, the Church, to draw near to him in faith, and thus to share in the joy of the wedding feast of the new and eternal covenant."

"FORGIVE FOR GOOD" by Dr. Fred Luskin
