### **SACRAMENTS**

**Reconciliation** - Saturdays at 3:00 p.m., Weekdays: 15 minutes prior to Mass or please call the pastor at 255-4600 for an appointment. If you are homebound and unable to come to the Church and need a priest to come to your home for confession, please call 255-4600 to set this up.

**Baptism** - The Baptism Preparation Program and Baptism Schedule are by arrangement. Please call the parish office at 255-4600 to register prior to your delivery date and the program director will return your call. Parents must be registered at Corpus Christi or have permission from their parish.

**Marriage** - Couples planning to be married should call the parish office at 255-4600 at least four months in advance. Completion of required paperwork and taking the FOCCUS premarital inventory is also needed this early. This process is usually administered the fourth Thursday of each month from 7:00-9:00 p.m.

**Natural Family Planning Classes** are offered by the Bismarck Diocese. The methods offered are Billings Ovulation Method, Creighton Model Fertility Care System, Marquette Model and Sympto-Thermal Methods. 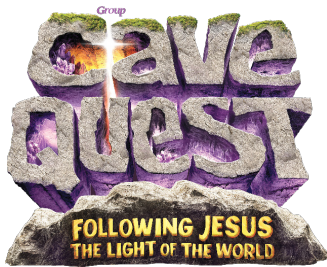

*The Holy Father Speaks...* Christians with a grimace or disgruntled expression on their faces, sad Christians, are a very ugly thing. However, they are not fully Christian. They think they are (Christians) but they are not fully so. This is the Christian message. And in this atmosphere of joy that today's liturgy gives us, like a gift, I would like to underline just two things: first - an attitude; second - a fact. The attitude is one of service or helping others. This is pointed out when the gospel describes Mary as setting off immediately and without hesitation to visit her cousin, despite being pregnant and despite the risk of meeting robbers along the routes. This young girl of 16 or 17 was courageous by getting up straightaway and setting out on her journey. The courageous women who are present in the Church: they are like Mary. These women bring up their families, these women are responsible for rearing their children, endure so many hardships, so much pain, women who look after the sick... Courageous. Serving others is a Christian sign. Whoever doesn't live to serve other people, doesn't serve to live. Serving others and being full of joy is the attitude that I would like to underline today. The second attitude is that there is joy in reaching out and meeting other people. Reaching out to others is another Christian sign. Referring once again to Mary's meeting with her cousin, the two kinswomen greeted each other with their joy and their encounter was very festive. In conclusion, if we could learn these two things: to serve others and reach out to them, how much our world would change. Through Mary's service towards others, through that encounter, our Lord's promise is renewed and makes it happen now, just as it did then. It is really our Lord that is about helping other people, the Lord is about meeting other people.
